Dear Parents/Guardians,

The procedure for informing you of school closings due to inclement weather will be done through our “Option C” student information system. You will receive a phone call from me with a recorded message with information concerning school closures or delays. I will also continue to use these means of notification as well: TV Channel 69 and www.WFMZ.com.

As in the past, we will follow the **East Penn School District** for closings and delays. If you do not live in the East Penn School District, for a **delayed opening** please follow the starting time for the **school district in which you live**. In the event of a delayed opening, morning Pre-K and morning Pre-School will be cancelled.

If bad weather occurs during the day and we have an early dismissal, you will again receive an Option C phone message at your daytime contact number. Early dismissal notices will also appear on Channel 69 and the internet as mentioned above. Please do not call the school office or rectory for this information. Phone lines must be kept open for emergency calls from various school districts. **Please be sure that your children know what to do in the event of an early dismissal. Please discuss alternate plans with your children now so that they will be prepared.**

For those parents who have children registered in our Extended Care Program, **Extended Care will open at 7:30AM on days when school opens late.** Please let Mrs. Elwert know if you plan to use this service at any time during the winter months so we can plan for proper staffing. If school is closed, the Extended Care Program is also closed. In the event of an early dismissal due to weather problems, **Extended Care will remain open for 2 hours after our school closing time on that day.** Please check your Extended Care Handbook where these policies are printed.


