

# CYO DISTRICT 2 ART SHOW CONTEST



After a hiatus of a few years, the CYO Art Show and Contest is returning on Sunday, April 23, 2023 in the cafeteria of St Ann School. Each grade school in the Diocese of Allentown is invited to participate.

The contest is open to students in grades 5-8 Entrants may submit any artwork personally completed from May 2022 through April 2023 under the following categories:

Painting 1 Oil, Acrylic or Tempra	Watercolors	Drawing 1 Grey lead pencil or charcoal	Pencils or Markers	Sculptures Wire, Paper, Metal, Ceramic
Mixed Media Projects using MORE than 2 mediums	Photography	Oil Pastel	Digital Art- produced by technology	Woodworking Wood turning, burning, carved or building

Students are not limited to one submission and may submit up to 1 artwork per category.

# Limits:

1. Exhibits should be kept to within 24"x36" (maximum size)

2. Drawings and Prints should be matted (may be mounted on construction paper) ready to display

3. Artwork submitted must be original work and have been produced by the student in the time period of May 2022 to April 2023.

4. Each item submitted must contain a label with the artist name, grade, school and category.

## JUDGING:

Judging will take place on Saturday, April 22 in private review and winners will be announced in the respective schools. Ribbons will be awarded to  $1,2,3^{rd}$  in each category as well as a maximum of 5 honorable mention ribbons per category. Ribbons will be displayed with the artwork on Sunday, April 23 between 9:30am to 12:30 pm.

Fill out registration form with required parental permission signature. Student registration forms are included in this notice. Forms may be printed out at home or requested from the art teacher.

ST ANN SCHOOL STUDENTS: Students may submit their entry artwork to Mrs. McDermott with the parent signed registration form in the art room during school hours on Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays until Friday, April 21, 2023 at 3 pm.

Students who attend grade schools in the Allentown Diocese other than St Ann School should submit their works to the art teacher at their school. The school art teacher is responsible for physically submitting the artworks to St. Ann School no later than Friday, April 21, 2023 at 3:30 pm.

Diocesan school art teachers may also drop work prior to April 21 to St Ann School Office during school hours of 9 am to 3 pm.
