Dear Parents/Guardians.

For nearly twenty years, the Diocese of Allentown has provided yearly child protection catechesis to students as part of the 2002 Charter for Protection of Youth and Young People, as required by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Over the years, child protection catechesis has been provided to tens of thousands of our students in Diocesan schools and PREP programs. The training programs used since the inception of safe environment efforts, Child Lures and Called to Protect, have served our students well.

In the past year, staff from the Secretariat for Catholic Health, Human Services and Youth Protection began reviewing child protection catechesis training programs to eventually replace Child Lures and Called to Protect. Staff from the Secretariat for Education, Evangelization and Formation participated in reviews of materials, as well as Directors of Religious Education and educators in Catholic schools across the Diocese.

We are pleased to announce that effective September 1, 2022, the Diocese of Allentown will begin using the Circle of Grace Program, developed by a team of educators and youth protection professionals in the Archdiocese of Omaha. The program is rooted in the Catholic faith and emphasizes dignity and respect for one's body, appropriate boundaries, and awareness of child protection topics, including online safety and grooming. Grade-appropriate modules are designed for K through 12 students and include information and resources for parents.

The Circle of Grace Program will be taught here at St. Ann's during the week of October 24, 2022.

I invite you to contact me if you have any questions about the Circle of Grace program or child protection catechesis in the Diocese of Allentown. The safety of our students is always our priority, and we hope you will take advantage of the parental resources included with the curriculum.

We ask that you continue to place your trust in us as we work together in partnership with you and your children in the complete educational process.
