- 5. Bring your finished project to school on the first day. A minimum of 5 entries is required.



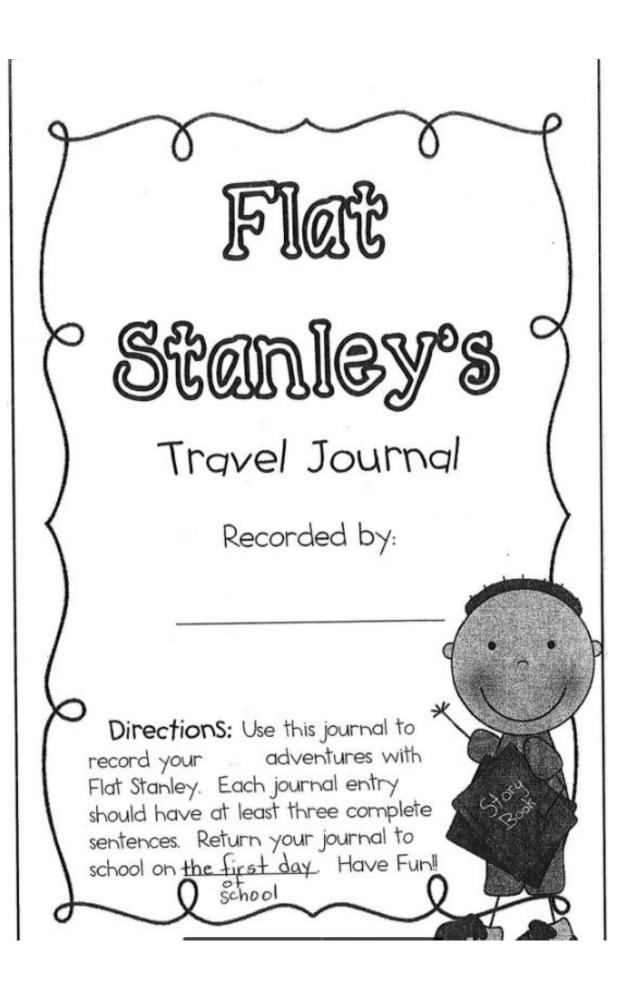
Flat Stanley: His Original Ad.

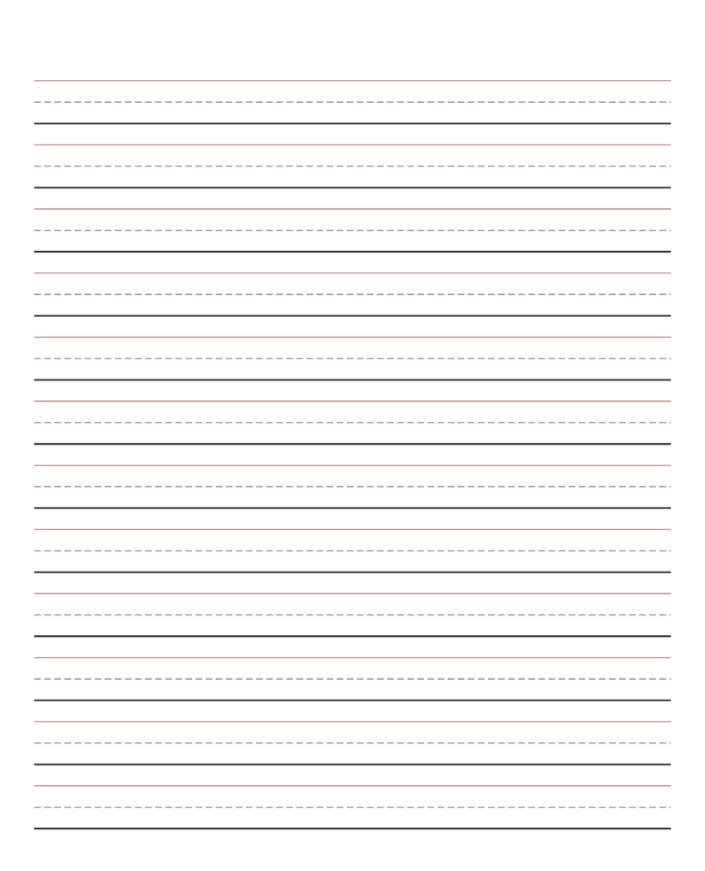


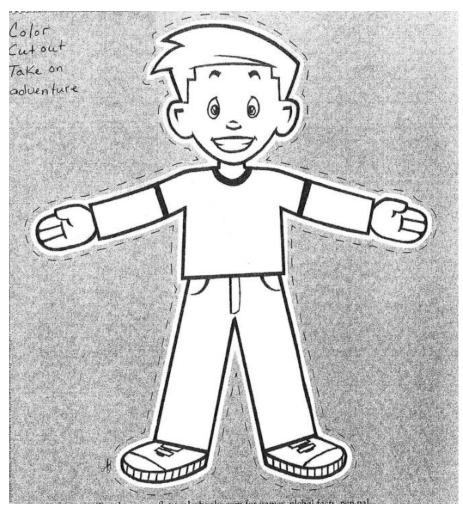
