_____ 3 D Printer Club Grades 6-8 (Mrs. Miller & Mrs. Hammond Moderators) Thursday 3:30-4:30
Limit 20 participants

Description: The 3D Printing Club is a place for students to collaborate on creative design and engineering solutions. Students will learn how to use online design software and basic components of a 3D printer. The five weeks will culminate in each club member having the opportunity to print their creative designs.

_____ Lego Club Grades 2-5 (Mrs. Leitzel, Moderator) Monday 3:30-4:30 Limit 15 participants

Students will meet weekly to participate in building activities using Legos. Each session will focus on imagination, creativity and working together to complete a task.
