Afternoon Pickup

Due to a neighborhood complaint and a visit from the Emmaus Police Department we needed to make some adjustments to our afternoon dismissal procedures. We needed to move dismissal up by five minutes. Zimbabwe Partner School Update

We are so excited to once again be partnering with the Mlomotsha Secondary School in Zimbabwe to help those students to receive a better education. With the continued help from Mrs. Caton we recently were able to provide Cecil Sibanda our Zimbabwe contact person with textbooks and trade books for the school. With a recent \$2,000.00 donation from St. Ann Parish the 40 students at the school will all be able to receive a daily lunch for the rest of the school year. Please read the following thank you letter from Cecil.

The Mlomotsha Secondary School opened in January 2022 and has an enrollment of 40 students.

Your donations have transformed a community and given them hope. Your faith has helped us convert a forest into a school. The school was built to reduce the distanced walked by students to the closest secondary school. Some were traveling up to 20 miles to school. For most of the students the distance was reduced by two thirds. The school is in an area with high levels of poverty and the AIDS pandemic has left many orphans. We pray for your continued support. Our school has recently started engaging in several income generating projects. Currently we have chickens and bees. On behalf of the Mlomotsha Secondary School I would like to thank the children and staff at St. Ann School and the parishioners of St. Ann Parish. We always thank God for our friends in America.


