



St. Ann School Scholarship Opportunities

The **Freeman Scholarship of the Church of St. Ann** is funded by a bequest of the Jeanne V. Freeman estate to be used to support Catholic education in our parish.

The **Angel Scholarship** is funded through private donations and special events.

The **Eastern Pennsylvania Scholarship Foundation** funding is made possible through the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Educational Improvement and Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit programs. These programs are funded by companies that contribute to scholarship organizations in exchange for a state tax credit. Students entering Kindergarten through Grade 8 for the 2020-2021 school year are eligible for scholarship consideration. Students may qualify for scholarships from more than one source; however, the total amount of scholarship funds awarded cannot exceed the yearly tuition amount. Families will not be eligible for any scholarship aid if there is an unpaid tuition balance from the previous school year. Funds are awarded based on greatest need.

Scholarship Application Process: Submit the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment application online through your FACTS account. A link to the online application is on the school website under Enrollment – Financial Assistance. **Scholarship applications will only be accepted online.** There is a \$23.00 non-refundable processing fee payable to FACTS.

Application Deadline: APRIL 17, 2020

Current Eligibility Requirements:

EITC - Income qualifications: \$105,842 maximum for a family with 1 child. Increased by \$15,842 for each additional dependent child.

OSTC - Eligible students must reside within the boundaries of one of the 15% lowest performing school districts in the State of Pennsylvania, and also meet the above EITC income qualifications.

All required financial and tax documents must be sent directly to FACTS, including a signed copy of your 2019 IRS Federal Form 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ tax return and copies of 2019 W-2 forms.
