Chrome Book Loan Policy

While your child's Chrome Book is on loan from St. Ann School the following policy will be in place:

Students & Parents acknowledge the receipt of the Chrome Book Acceptable Use Policy. If you forget what you and your child signed at the beginning of the year you can find the policy under the parent tab of our website under policies & forms.

The Chrome Book is an essential part of learning, just as a textbook would be. Students will be responsible for the Chrome Book in the same manner as a textbook. All equipment will be returned to the school in good operating condition.

Parents/Guardians are responsible for student use and monitoring while the Chrome Book is off school property. The Chrome Book is to be used for educational purposes only. It is not the student's personal social media device. Just as in school the history of the Chrome Book will be checked when the Chrome Book is returned to school.

The Chrome Book is for use by the student it is assigned to. No other family members are permitted to use the School issued Chrome Book.

Loss of the student's Chrome Book must be reported immediately to the administration and the Student or Parent/Guardian will be responsible for replacement at \$270.

Any damage other than normal wear and tear will be the responsibility of the student/parents. The Student and Parent/Guardian also agree they will be responsible to St. Ann School for the cost to repair or replace the Chrome Book. The Student and Parent/Guardian understand and agree they are not to attempt any repairs on the Chrome Book and any Chrome Book that becomes damaged must be reported immediately to the administration.

Parent/Guardian and students agree that the student has no right to alter, install or remove any hardware or software on the Chrome Book that is owned and installed by the school.

Failure to return the Chrome Book to the school in a timely manner or the continued use of the Chrome Book for non-school purposes without the School's written consent may be considered unlawful possession of School property and the school may pursue legal means to obtain the Chrome Book or its value.
